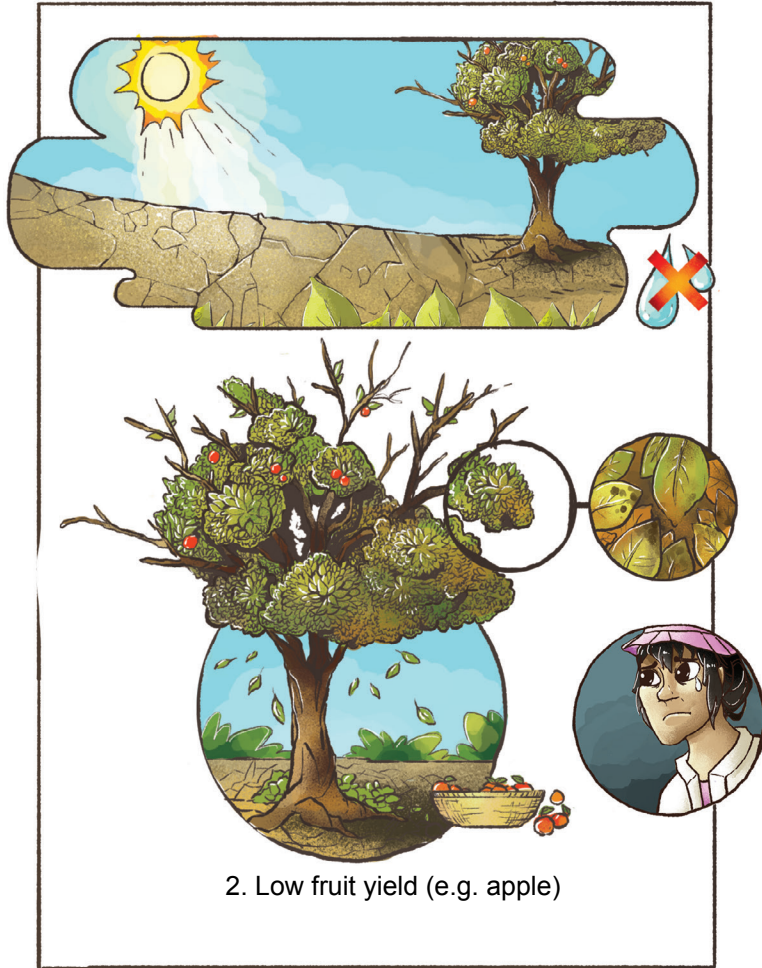


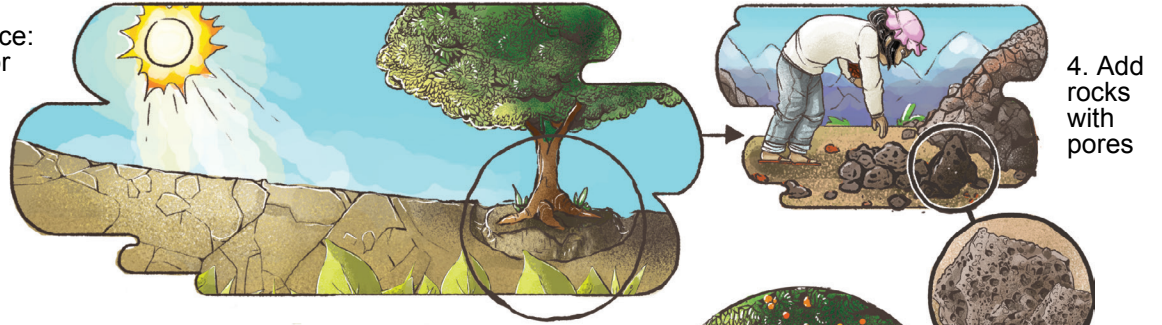
Lesson: Fruit trees can be grown in dry climates by harvesting rainwater around tree using porous rocks

1. Traditional practice: no water collected

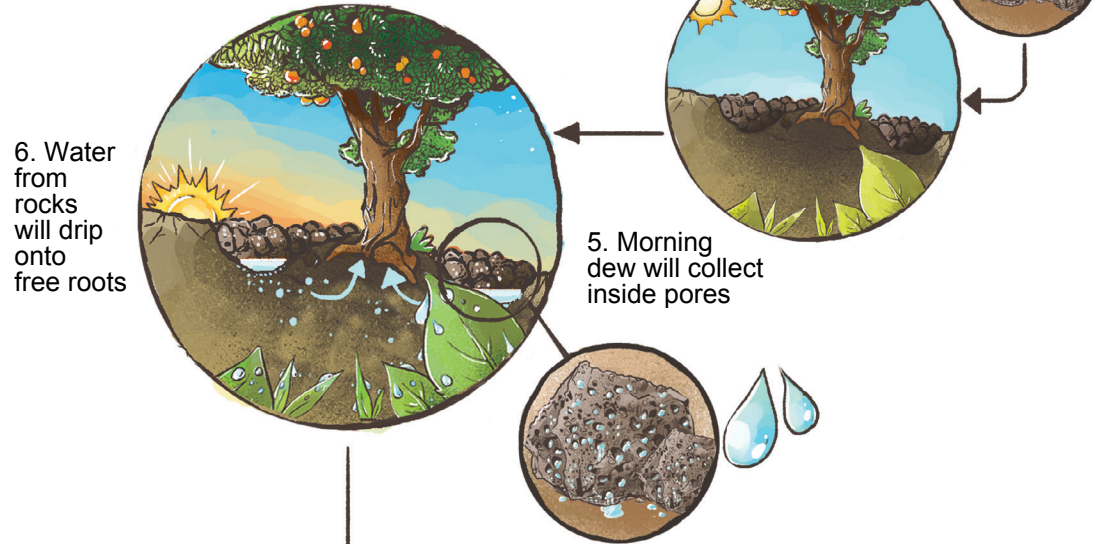


2. Low fruit yield (e.g. apple)

3. Improved practice: create short wall or pit around tree

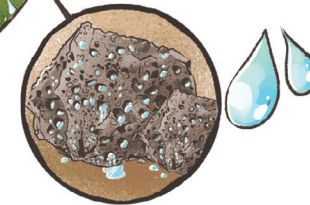


4. Add rocks with pores



5. Morning dew will collect inside pores

6. Water from rocks will drip onto free roots



7. High fruit yield
